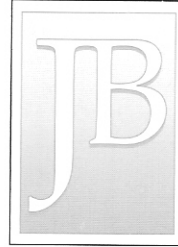

The Recertification Process - *Simplified*

The Professional Certification Board (PCB) recently informed volunteer leaders about the implementation of the new Continuing Professional Education (CPE) system, beginning January 2008, for calculating recertification credits. A supporting PowerPoint presentation was placed on the ASIS International website to provide assistance in explaining this transition to your Chapter constituents.

New presentation online in addition to CPE...

While undergoing this process, the PCB realized that additional support was still needed because most certificants were vague about the value of recertifying and the important impact it has on their career. It was therefore necessary to develop another presentation, which will be a useful tool in explaining the basics of continued learning and activities that can help achieve recertification goals.
